Pupil Premium - this is additional money given to the school by the Government for children in receipt of Free School Meals, Cared for Children, Post Looked After Children and Children whose parents are in the Armed Forces

Outcomes of support and the impact of PP spend will be assessed at the end of the Autumn, Spring and Summer terms. Academic progress will be monitored as will development of confidence and social skills in pupils. Any gaps between children receiving PP and the rest of the school will be addressed throughout the academic year.

The results shown below are the average points of progress of the cohort made over the previous school year alongside the results of the PP children within that cohort. As our school numbers are so small, it makes the data difficult to interpret and raises questions as to the significance of the comparison. A much clearer picture is gleaned on a case study basis, which is how we prefer to follow the progress of our children in receipt of pupil premium
